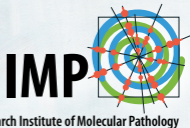

Research Technician Position Available (Full-time)

The successful applicant should have experience in molecular biological techniques (such as DNA/RNA preparation, PCR, RT-PCR and molecular cloning). He or she should be well-organized, highly motivated and willing to learn new techniques, able to work independently as well as in a team. Experience with genetics and/or *C. elegans* will be highly regarded. Good English-language communication skills are essential.

The main responsibilities will be ensuring the smooth day-to-day running of the laboratory (including managing supplies and reagents), molecular biology work, and work with *C. elegans* (such as managing a frozen strain collection, microinjection, microscopy and genetics). For interested candidates there will be opportunities to pursue an independent research project.

We offer a young, dynamic, and international working environment, further training in molecular biology and genetics, and the chance to make an important contribution to basic biomedical research.
