

Technical Assistant Position Available

The newly formed Campbell Lab in the University of Vienna at the Max F. Perutz Laboratories is seeking a highly motivated, organized, and experienced full-time technician to aid in the establishment of the Lab. The lab is primarily focused on using budding yeast to study mechanisms of chromosome segregation.

Responsibilities

The successful candidate will be in charge of the general management of the lab as well as performing experiments. The basic duties include: ordering, maintenance of lab equipment, basic training of students, and preparation of lab reagents.

Qualifications

The successful candidate is expected to have theoretical and practical knowledge of basic molecular biology techniques, including PCR, cloning, and Western blotting, and must be able to participate in both independent and collaborative research projects. Candidates should have laboratory training (CTA, MTA, FH or equivalent), good command of the English language, good communication/interaction skills, good organization skills, and an interest in learning and mastering new techniques.

The position is available from May 2015 for 2 years with the possibility of extension. Salary will meet the CTA levels.
