In this position you will work in the Research Group Synthetic Biology and Molecular biology **embedded at the Institute of Chemical, Environmental and Bioscience Engineering at TU Vienna** in the team of Ass. Prof. Matthias Steiger. The research team focuses on the production of biochemicals using industrial relevant microorganisms like yeast and filamentous fungi. The lab is based in the city center of Vienna (Gumpendorfer Straße 1A).

That's what you will do

- Maintain and service the laboratory
- Cultivate and maintain cell lines in a GMP environment
- Perform regular quality and contamination checks
- Refill supplies and reagents
- Supervise and enforce laboratory safety rules
- Make sure things are running as they should
- Be responsible for analysis of culture supernatants and titers
- Supervise and organise the cell freezer data base and maintain liquid nitrogen storage

Experience a collegial work culture full of enthusiasm for your job, real flexibility and friendliness. You are part of a challenging and helpful work environment full of team spirit and friendship.

Ideally you have completed a technical education (for instance Rosensteingasse, or a Bachelor in (bio)chemistry, molecular biology or related field) and you speak and write english and german fluently. If you have a Master's degree in a relevant field, this also fits. In this case please be aware that this is not a research position – we want you to be satisfied with your role and not disappointed.

A research lab is a dynamic environment and you like to communicate and interact with others, organize yourself and others.

Experiences in the following areas would be fine, but are not a prerequisite:

- Working in a biochemistry laboratory
- Cloning and genetic engineering skills
- Experience with HPLC
- Cultivation of microorganisms

In addition, you should enjoy the work in an international interdisciplinary environment.
