To complement our international team (working language is English), we seek applications for a mouse colony manager / laboratory technician who will support the laboratory.

### Responsibilities

- General support of the research team and organization of the laboratory
- Maintenance, breeding and genotyping of transgenic mouse colony
- Perfusion and dissection of transgenic mice for analysis
- Preparation of tissue sections using cryostat
- Running standard immunohistochemistry
- The position is **initially limited for 2 years (Karenzvertretung)** but with the possibility for extension and/or unlimited contract (depending upon satisfactory performance)

- Experience with breeding and maintenance of transgenic mice
- Extensive experience in molecular biology, PCR, genotyping
