Currently, we are looking for a Lab Manager/ Full Time (m/f/d) with experience in:

- Maintaining laboratory equipment and arranging replacement, service, and repair

In addition, we are planning the refurbishing of news labs (~450m2). This includes adapting the layout, installing proper air condition, furnishing the labs with suitable lab furniture and purchasing specialized laboratory equipment. We have done so before and have suitable contacts for every one of these tasks, but need the Lab Manager to help organize and project manage this large task in Q1 and Q2-2022.

Good knowledge on MS Word and Excel is a prerequisite for your daily work. As Aelian Biotechnology operates in an international environment, good English skills are required.

To be formally eligible, you should have completed a Master's Degree and should have 2 to 3 years of relevant experience working in a laboratory – ideally as a lab manager. We are looking for team players that have strong organizational and project management skills.

The position is a full-time position (40h per week; 8h per day) with a permanent contract. The monthly salary amounts to 2.650 EUR gross income. A higher salary is possible depending on the experience and fit of the candidate.
