At the Center for Cancer Research we conduct research from the laboratory to the patient and vice versa. Due to the affiliation of the center to the Medical University of Vienna and the proximity to the AKH Wien (Vienna General Hospital), basic research and clinic can work together very closely and the research results flow directly into diagnosis and therapy. To achieve this goal, we analyze, among other things, tumor tissue and blood from cancer patients or animals for the expression of various proteins or genetic changes.

We offer an interesting and varied field of work in a collegial, appreciative and dynamic team.

The work area is divided into the following activities:

- Planning and implementation of histological and molecular biological working methods
- Cutting particularly difficult specimens, such as tissue micro arrays, "Swiss rolls" or tissue punches
- Archiving and management of blood and tissue samples
- Support of the devices during ongoing operation, contact with the technicians and the coordination of maintenance
- Requirements planning, ordering and organizing the required reagents and materials
- Training of new personnel, especially graduate and doctoral students, in the various histological techniques, such as tissue processing, tissue embedding, sectioning of paraffin samples, histological staining, immunohistochemistry and microscopy
- Coordination of ongoing operations and billing with the individual work groups
